REPORT OF DECEASED VOTER

Instructions

Minnesota election officials get regular reports of deceased residents from the MN Department of Health and Social Security Administration, and use these to change voters' status to "deceased." If you believe a deceased voter was not included in these reports, you can use this form to notify the county elections office of the deceased voter.

To use this form, complete all fields below, including signature, and return it to the county election office from the county where the deceased voter resided.
